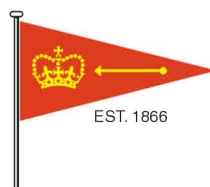

INSTRUCTIONS TO FULL MEMBERSHIP APPLICANTS

- 1** The Royal Dart Yacht Club welcomes applicants for Membership. The Assistant Secretary will be pleased to help at any stage of application as will the Honorary Secretary and Membership Secretary.

- 2** Applicants are required to complete a form, available from the rack in the Foyer, the Secretaries' Office, or downloaded from the website www.royaldart.co.uk. The form should be sent to the Club for the attention of the Membership Secretary.

- 3** Categories of membership and subscription fees are detailed on the attached sheet. The full rights and privileges of Members are defined in the Club Bye-laws and in the Constitution and Rules of the Club.

- 4** Applicants will be required to provide the details of two referees who will be approached by the Membership Secretary. Ideally, referees should be Members of the Royal Dart Yacht Club who have known the applicant for at least a year. If the applicant does not know any RDYC members then references from members of other yacht clubs will be accepted. If this is not possible, please speak to the Hon. Secretary.

- 5** Flag Officers and the General Committee encourage all applicants to attend an "At Home" function at the Club. This is a drinks reception held in the Bar on the first Saturday of each month, with the option of dinner in the Dining Room. If applicants are unable to attend an "At Home" they will be asked to meet the Commodore or Membership Secretary.

- 6** Subject to the approval of the General Committee, applicant details (page 1 only of the application form) will be posted on the Club Noticeboard for at least 14 days for Members to consider.

- 7** The application is then considered again at the following General Committee meeting for approval and election.

- 8** Once the application is approved by the General Committee, the entrance fee and subscription becomes payable. Applicants become members of the Club and are free to use the full range of Club facilities. In the event that the fees are not paid within one month, the membership application becomes void. The Committee can waive this condition in exceptional circumstances (e.g. prolonged absence overseas).
